They have pledged £57,500 towards the research being done by Professor Chris Jones and his team into diffuse midline glioma (DMG) and we are incredibly grateful for their recent donation of £28,750.

The funds donated by The Ellie Mawdsley Foundation will enable Dr Molina Das in Professor Chris Jones' team to undertake vital experiments to better understand how DMG cells evade treatment, and screen potential promising drug candidates.
